14-56/2022-PCI (B) (Approval Process for 2022-23 a.s.) (New Instts)

- 9.1 The latest information on record was placed and considered.
- 9.2 The status of new institutions were displayed during EC meeting.
- 9.3 Decisions under Item No.1 and 16 of 386 EC (17th December, 2022), regarding inspection reports where inspection was conducted on or before 16.12.2022 received in office, it was noted that -
- a) PCI office is in process of verification of inspection reports.
